ITEM #1: PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT: PILOT OF SCHOOL OUTREACH PROGRAM

Mr. Carlos Gonzalez, Public Involvement and Community Outreach Coordinator, and Ms. Dale Stith, Transportation Planner, will provide an overview of a pilot school outreach program being developed at Linkhorn Elementary School in Virginia Beach. Based on the lessons learned from this preliminary program, the program is envisioned as being an additional community outreach tool available for HRTPO staff.

ITEM #2: REVENUE ESTIMATE PRELIMINARY REVIEW

VDOT staff recently provided MPOs with revenue forecasts for use in the development of their long-range transportation plans. Mr. Andy Pickard, Principal Transportation Engineer, will provide a preliminary review of the forecast.
