UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM

- Per Federal regulations, federally funded metropolitan transportation planning activities must be documented in a unified planning work program (UPWP).
- The UPWP documents the planning priorities for the HRTPO metropolitan planning area and describes all planning activities to be performed with transportation and transit planning funds.
- Throughout the year, the UPWP serves as a guide for planners, citizens, and elected officials to be aware of transportation planning activities in the region.
- The HRTPO works in partnership with local, state and federal elected officials to plan for, and bring needed transportation investments to Hampton Roads.
